**AMENDMENT NO 4 TO THE LICENCE TO DIGICEL CAYMAN

WHEREAS Digicel Cayman Limited was granted a Licence dated 17 October 2003;

AND WHEREAS Digicel Cayman Limited has requested that its Licence be amended to adjust its fixed wireless services roll out schedule as follows:

AND WHEREAS the Information and Communications Technology Authority is in agreement with the adjusted roll out schedule;

THEREFORE pursuant to sections 23 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2004 Revision), Annex 1A of the Digicel Cayman Limited Licence dated 17 October 2003 is amended accordingly.

ANNEX 1A

Roll Out Plan

ICT Networks

The 2G and 2.5G mobile networks will be operational throughout the Cayman Islands no later than 1 February 2004. The international satellite network will be operational no later than 1 April 2004. The fixed wireless network will be operational throughout Grand Cayman no later than 31 October 2005.

ICT Services

Mobile telephony, resale of telephony, retail sale of ICT equipment and the provision of ICT infrastructure will be made available throughout the Cayman Islands no later than 1 February 2004.

Fixed telephony, application services, internet service, and internet telephony services will be made available in Grand Cayman according to the following schedule:

Voice	Business	31 October 2005
Data	Business	31 October 2005
Internet	Business	30 November 2005
Voice	Residential	30 June 2006
Internet	Residential	30 June 2006

Breach of Condition

A breach of this Condition will constitute a breach of the Licence for which the Licence may be revoked.
